Construction and Installation Instructions				
A permit must be obtained from the Borough prior to any construction, reconstruction, or repair of the curb or sidewalk in front of or along the property line. Where new curb or sidewalk is to be installed, the property owner or contractor shall obtain the line and grade of the curb and/or sidewalk from the Borough before starting work. All work shall conform to Borough standards as specified in Ordinance 2012-06 and any "specification sheets" both of which are available upon request.				
NOTE: YOU MUST CONTACT THE BOROUGH FOR AN INSPECTION OF THE SUB-BASE MATERIALS AND FORMS AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF POURING CONCRETE AND THE AIR TEMPERATURE MUST BE 40° OR ABOVE TO POUR CONCRETE.
