#### NOTEWORTHY ACTIVITIES:

We participated in a DUI Roving Patrol over the Thanksgiving Holiday as part of the Franklin County DUI Taskforce. The Officer assigned had a DUI arrest that also resulted in fight during which the Officer sustained minor injuries.

We are actively working with Franklin County Mental Health to seek out a replacement for the Co-Responder program. An RFP was recently completed and interviews should begin shortly.

As a result of the Drug Take Back Box located in the GPD Lobby a total of 177 lbs. of medication has been turned in for destruction this year.

On Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, assisted by family and Public Works, GPD delivered three trucks of food collected from the community to the local Food Pantry.
