"Water Authority is Compliant with Pennsylvania DEP Drinking Water Lead Regulations"

The Greencastle Area, Franklin County Water Authority confirmed that the system is in compliance with Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) regulations related to lead in drinking water. Since the Authority remained in consistent compliance with lead regulations for many years, the lead monitoring mandated by DEP is required once every three years.

Despite historical compliance with DEP lead regulations, the Authority recently reviewed system operations and had an independent Corrosion Potential Evaluation performed in April 2016. The result is Greencastle Water Authority *is in regulatory compliance with the Pennsylvania DEP lead and copper rule and there is no indication of any risk to public health.*

The Authority's next testing cycle under the PA DEP guidelines will take place later this year and the results will be reported in the 2016 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report and other media.
