I had occasion to meet with Mental Heal and Law Enforcement reps from another PA county looking to start a Co-Responder program like we have here. They were impressed with the results of the program and what it does for both law enforcement and the community in general.

The month of October saw a series of Criminal Mischiefs and Thefts from vehicles. Those incidents are currently under investigation.

We also saw an extraordinary number of calls this past moth with the total at 382. October of 2018 saw calls for service at 268, a 42 % increase.

There have also been some questions about the nature of a "Directed Patrol". They are just as the name implies specific patrols focused at specific problems, for instance foot patrols at the Playground. We also do these at some local businesses and Borough facilities at the request of other Department Heads. These are almost exclusively proactive in nature.
