Who should attend?

If you are concerned that a loved one is at risk for overdosing on a prescription pain medication or heroin, this training is for you!

What will you learn?

Participants will learn how to:

- Recognize opioid medications and the signs of an overdose,
- Respond to an overdose situation, and
- Revive a victim of opioid overdose by administering Naloxone (Narcan).

What is Naloxone?

Naloxone (Narcan) is a medication that reverses an opioid overdose. It cannot be used to get high and it is NOT addictive. **Narcan is available to program participants at the conclusion of the training.**
