Mr. Stover of the Water department explained that he had had complaint that water pipes had frozen on the Bitner farm and that the owners mainstined that the borough would have to repair the same in accordance with an alleged agreement when the right of way was secured. It was the consensus of opinion that evenqif such an obligation should be required, it certainly would not extend to the matter of frozen pipes or other conditions caused by carelessness. On motion of Mr. Frank, seconded by Mr. Lesher, it was ordered that repairs be not made at borough expense.
